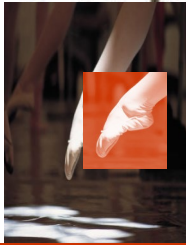

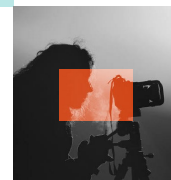

Fall Curricular Electives



Music Theory

Explore Music Theory & History:

In this course, students will study the language and symbols of music throughout history. Not only will students learn to read various musical elements, such as scales, chords, pitch notations, and time signatures, they will also learn to construct these elements themselves. The course also teaches students to understand basic forms in music compositions, including the skill of notation.



Art

Explore & Make Art:

Introduces students to the materials, techniques, concepts, and processes essential to understanding the visual arts and the role of the artist throughout history. Vocal Group

Vocal Ensemble:

Vocal Ensemble is designed to give voice students an opportunity to perform in specialized choral literature. Content of the course will include the study of musicianship, foreign language pronunciation, contemporary styles and proper rehearsal/performance.

Band



Beginning, Intermediate & Advanced Band:

This classes are open to all brass, percussion and woodwind players or those who wish to focus on improving their ensemble playing in a band setting. Development of basic musicianship and playing skills will be emphasized through performance in this band. Students will perform out in the community, school concerts and some athletic events.

Piano Lab



Pops to Praise Keyboards:

In addition to basic piano instruction this course contains improv, keyboard geography, easy rhythm patterns, c position note reading, and playing songs from a variety of books: incorporating other method book songs, praise and worship songs, Intro to Pop, etc.

Drum Team

Drum Team:

Drum Team students learn to become active members in a working and performing drum group. All students will learn to play snare drum, bass drum, cymbals, and smaller instruments of the battery as well as "found" percussion such as Trash Cans, etc.



Dance



Course, Product, or Service Description:

Students become acquainted with basic technique in ballet, modern, and jazz, as well as anatomical awareness that is pervasive throughout their lives. Gaining movement skills and finding confidence and enjoyment through movement are a focus of this class. No previous dance experience is necessary. This course may be used for Physical Education credit.
